DAY ONE - ARRIVE IN NOVA SCOTIA

DAY TWO - PORT ROYAL HABITATION & FORT ANNE

Pass through French Acadia settlements, fishing centers, rich orchards & farmlands. Visit Port Royal Habitation, a reconstruction of one of the oldest settlements in North America. Visit Fort Anne, a national historic site built upon the central area of conflict between the English & French for control of North America. Dinner at the hotel. ♦ **B, D**



DAY THREE - GRAND PRE NATIONAL HISTORIC PARK

Breakfast at the hotel. Guided tour of the Grand Pre National Historic Park, the setting of Longfellow's poem, Evangeline. Travel to Cape Breton Island where Scottish, Acadian, Irish & English traditions blend. Lodging at the historic Inverary Inn, Baddeck, Cape Breton Island, Nova Scotia for 2 nights. This charming inn is located on the shores of beautiful Bras d'Or Lakes. Dinner at the Inverary Inn. ♦ **B, D**

DAY FOUR - CABOT TRAIL

Breakfast at the hotel. Full day guided tour of the breathtaking Cabot Trail on the northern part of Cape Breton Island. View the dramatic coastline where the mountains meet the sea. Lunch included at Keltic Lodge. Return to the hotel for a free evening. Dinner at the Inn. ♦ **B, L, D**

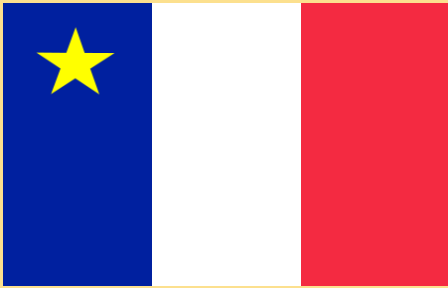
